The intent of this policy is to ensure a common understanding of the environmental objectives and values of the Company among our employees and other stakeholders. This policy states the Company's commitment to:

- Conduct our business in an environmentally responsible and sustainable manner while ensuring compliance with the Company's policies, programs and environmental laws and regulations.
- Maintain an environmental management system that strives to meet and exceed industry best management practices consistent with the goals of the Company.
- Provide adequate resources to manage our environmental practices including training all employees who are responsible for elements of our environmental management programs.
- Assess and monitor the environmental aspects of the Company's operations to understand associated environmental hazards and risks and ensure continual improvements in their management.
- Minimize the environmental impact of our operations by implementing environmental and sustainability programs regarding waste generation, water use and energy consumption.
- Recognize that climate change is a real threat to society and may have potential business impacts.
- Promote environmental sustainability to outside stakeholders that we can influence and our operations through employee education and training, research & development and process changes that promote the concepts of:
 - 1. **Reduce** our overall consumption of energy and resources.
 - 2. Recycle continue and improve our reclaim and recycling efforts.
 - 3. Renew support the generation of clean green energy.
 - 4. Replenish evaluate opportunities and partnerships to reduce our business impacts.
